Furniture designer Alexandra von Furstenberg (daughter-in-law of famed fashion designer Diane), has unveiled a limited edition collection of acrylic furniture, cementing her place in the world of interior design.

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Her new sophomore nine-piece collection follows a design ethos carved out by the designer's maiden furniture collection, and features strong use of acrylic, mirror and bold Art Deco-inspired angular motifs.

While her debut collection was previously inspired by diamonds and a neon color palette, Voltage has a more mature, classic feel, and would gel seamlessly into any contemporary space.



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Von Furstenberg's collection is full of smoldering colors such as bronze, smoke and black; the highlight of the new collection is a dramatic emerald-shaped coffee table made from clear acrylic that uses smart angles to catch and refract light to surprising effect.

This table, the Bullet, retails for \$15,000, and is available at her eponymous showroom at 9001 Melrose Avenue in Los Angeles, California. Other pieces of furniture in the collection start at \$1,200 – all designs come in limited quantity, and are signed for authenticity.
